The European Society of Minimally Invasive Neurological Therapy (ESMINT) and the European Society of Neuroradiology (ESNR) sign a Memorandum of Understanding

Zurich, Switzerland: ESMINT and ESNR have signed an agreement to formalize their collaboration. The purpose is to strengthen their joint commitment to education, training, examination, and certification in interventional neuroradiology (INR) across Europe.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) establishes a framework for joint initiatives to promote the common interests of both societies, ensuring efficient communication and cooperation in representing the discipline of interventional neuroradiology at both national and European levels.

The MoU was signed by Dr. Anne Christine Januel and Prof. Tarek Yousry, Presidents of ESMINT and ESNR, respectively, alongside Prof. Christian Taschner, General Secretary of ESMINT, Prof. Andrea Rossi, Vice-President of ESNR, Dr. Zsolt Kulcsár, Past President of ESMINT, and Prof. Cem Calli, Treasurer of ESNR.

“This historic agreement is a significant step forward in establishing unified standards for neurointerventional practices across Europe,” said Dr. Anne Christine Januel. “By collaborating closely, ESMINT and ESNR will enhance the quality of care for patients and ensure that practitioners throughout the continent adhere to the highest standards.”

The agreement aims to strengthen the commitment of both societies to ongoing collaboration by advancing unified standards for interventional neuroradiological practices throughout Europe. By emphasizing specialized training, education, examination, and certification, ESMINT and ESNR are dedicated to fostering an environment where practitioners can thrive, ultimately enhancing the quality of care for patients.
