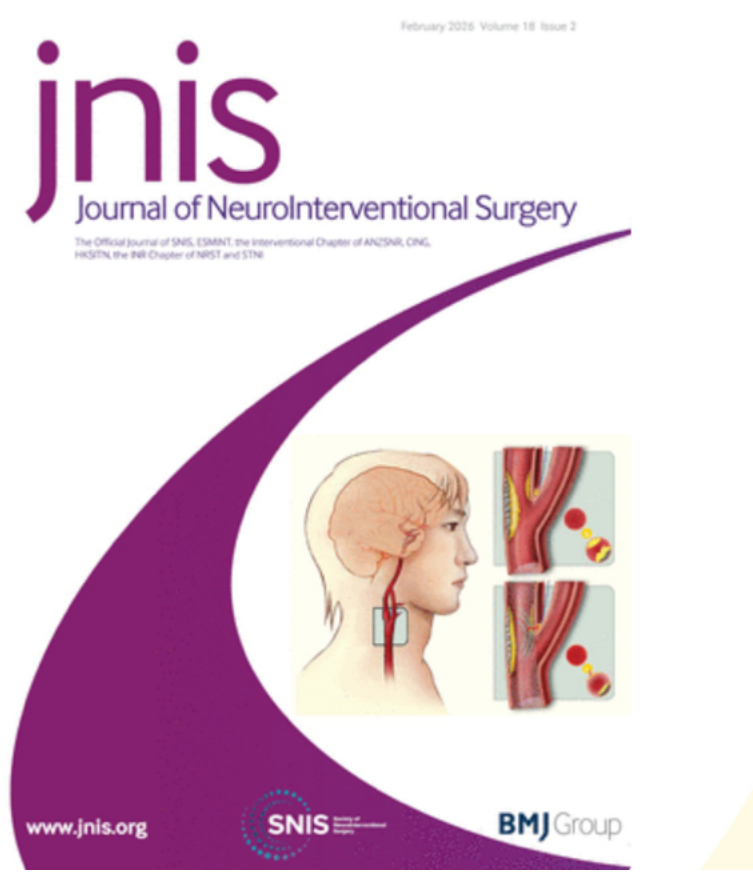
Skills 3.1 – Apply Now
