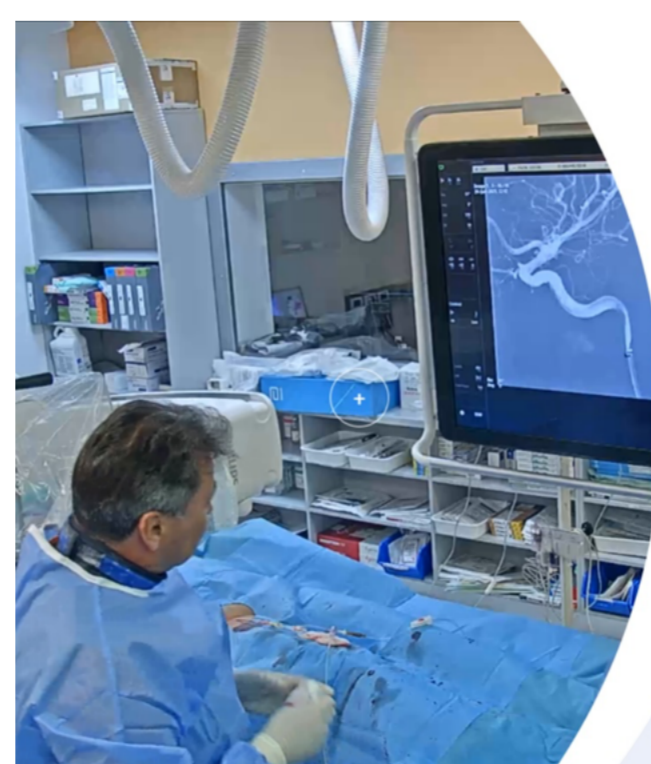
#### Female Speaker Launch
