This intensive theoretical course is a crucial contribution to neurointerventions training and education. Your leadership and expertise will play a vital role in ensuring the success and continued excellence of this important educational event.
▪ EXMINT Committee Chair	As the Chair, you will be responsible for overseeing and coordinating The European Stroke Course in Minimally Invasive Neurological Therapy (EXMINT). This theoretical stroke course serves as a condensed, essential training for neurointerventional ischemic stroke treatment. Your leadership will be instrumental in ensuring the smooth organization of the two 5-day courses, including lectures, small group tutorials, debates, and tests.

Your responsibilities will include supervising the selection process, collaborating with renowned experts to establish curriculum guidelines, and ensuring a seamless experience for fellows and e-fellows throughout their journey.

The deadline for applications is Saturday, 5 August 2023, 23.59 CEST.

All full members in good standing will be informed of the candidates and the procedure for voting next month. Voting for the elections will start approximately 20 days before the meeting.
